Dear Parents,

Spring has arrived! We look forward to some warmer days this month! Remember to dress your child warmly as this time of year can still be quite cold on the playground in the early morning. Warm sweaters, jackets and mittens should be available in the child's backpack on those colder days.

We have some exciting activities planned for this month. This month we have two special activity days. The first is **Mother's Day** and it takes place on **May 10th**. We will be talking about how special moms are to us and the children will be preparing something special to take home for their moms. The second is **Royalty Day** and it takes place on **May 17th**. I would also like to remind all parents about our policy regarding food. Outside food is not permitted in the Centre unless approved by the Supervisor in advance. If you plan to bring outside food for a celebration, please ensure that you get approval from the teacher or Supervisor in advance. Remember that any outside food that is brought in should be dropped off in the classroom with the teacher. You must label the food with the child's name as well all ingredients in the food. We cannot allow any food into the centre that has nuts or "may contain peanuts or tree nuts". We cannot accept any food that does not show the ingredients on the label. Please do not drop off food in the kitchen. The kitchen is restricted to staff only as we need to maintain a strict control of all food that enters the facility for the protection of our children with allergies and food restrictions. Please also remember that no food should be in the child's backpack. If we find food in the backpack, it will be discarded immediately.
